30 Hour EYEE funding for 3 to 4 year olds

Is your child eligible for the 30 hour Funding?

You may be able to get up to 30 hours free childcare (1,140 hours per year) which can be taken across 3 settings.

If you're eligible for the extra hours, you sign up online at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to get a code, which you will need to email or bring in to Laura Ceylan along with your national insurance number. This will then need to be approved by East Sussex before we are able to validate it.

You will need to apply either by the 31st August, 31st December and 31st March each year. Funding will begin at the beginning of the nursery term.

How to find out if you are Eligible (Information from <https://www.gov.uk/help-with-childcare-costs/free-childcare-and-education-for-2-to-4-year-olds>)

You can usually get 30 hours free childcare if you (and your partner, if you have one) are:

- in work - or getting parental leave, sick leave or annual leave
- each earning at least the National Minimum Wage or Living Wage for 16 hours a week - this is £120 if you're over 25

This earnings limit doesn't apply if you're self-employed and started your business less than 12 months ago.

You're not eligible if:

- your child doesn't usually live with you
- the child is your foster child
- either you or your partner has a [taxable income](#) over £100,000

You can get 30 hours free childcare at the same time as claiming Universal Credit, tax credits or childcare vouchers.

Continued Eligibility

If you already have the code and your child is receiving the 30 hour funding, there is a valid end date. It is your responsibility to log back into your account and check your eligibility, then re-submit your claim.

If you do not do this before the end date of your funding then you will be liable to pay the fees at the nursery until you are able to re-start your funding again. If your child is claiming 22.8 hours a week, then the weekly charge will be £114. If your child is claiming 30 hours a week, then the weekly charge will be £150.

The nursery will not be able to remind you of your funding end date, this is your responsibility.
